## IMPULSE CONTROL

Practicing emotional self-control, also known as impulse control, is an extremely important skill that every dog can benefit from. In an exciting environment like daycare, impulse control is essential for smooth transitions throughout our day This is something that can be practiced anywhere and everywhere, and will benefit your pup during exciting circumstances.

Some simple ways to practice impulse control at home with your dog include:

- Sitting and waiting until your pup is settled at doors/thresholds (before getting out of the car, before exiting the house at doorways)
- Sitting and waiting until your pup is settled before feedings.
- Sitting and waiting until your pup is settled before playing with toys.
- Practicing the "Leave it" command with treats, food and toys.
